Our Average vs. National Average

(Greater is better)





Our Neurological Diagnosis Rehabilitation patients are discharged to the community more frequently than national average. Based on CMS definition of community = home, board and care, and assisted living.

LENGTH OF STAY (Lower is better)



12.5 days

Our program's Neurological Diagnosis Rehabilitation patients had a lower LOS than national average, with higher percentage discharged to community as above.

QI GAIN (Greater is better)



Our Average

21.6

National Weighted Average

From admission to discharge, FIM gain (functional improvement) is greater within our hospital than national weighted averages (our patients gained more functional outcomes as compared to national users).

QI SCORE ON DISCHARGE (Greater is better)



50.5

Our Neurological Diagnosis Rehabilitation patients' functional scores are higher than national average upon discharge.
